Eco-Schools Topic	Energy Year 4
Aim	To try to reduce energy costs across the school. To increase awareness of ways to save energy and have a healthy classroom to work in.
Action(s)	<p>Action 1: Research what a comfortable room temperature should be.</p> <p>Cold weather and classroom temperature (England) National Education Union</p> <p>By November 29th</p> <p>Action 2: Create labels/poster to display in classrooms to help reduce excessive use of energy.</p> <p>All classrooms to have a thermometer with a guide next to it for the advised temperature and actions to take if too hot and too cold. Often the heating is cranked right up and it is unbearably hot. In a very small effort to reduce energy costs!</p> <p>By December 6th</p> <p>Action3: Hand out thermometers to classes and explain purpose of labels.</p> <p>Put thermometers next to the co2 monitors. This will then encourage air quality and ventilation as well.</p> <p>Action 4: Promote Earth Hour in March.</p>
