Oak – the time should be the day of the start and the end of the Olympics

Sycamore – football, javelin, archery, dodgeball, running, gymnastics, tennis, netball, relay, high jump, basketball, bench ball, hockey, cycling, hockey, dancing, handball. To take place in the summer term

Larch – dance and gymnastic, cricket, tennis, relay and racing.

Lime – gymnastics, hurdles. Most flexible competition, fencing, archery, rugby, sumo wrestling, discus, badminton, swimming, basketball, ping pong, tug of war, rhythmic gymnastics, To be held in May. Family Olympic values is the same as ours.

Silverbirch – 100m, 1000m, cross country, long jump, triple jump, football, golf.

Blackthorn – rounders, basketball. In the summer.

Mr. Green – shared his plan for the Olympic Festival – 8 teachers with 8 countries. 1 country from each continent. Best to run this in the summer the final two weeks. 3 or 4 children per class in each country. On the Friday, allocate the children for the events, research their country and paint a t-shirt with the countries flag.

Run the events over 2 week – sports in the morning – end of each day – medal ceremony.
