Theme for the meeting:

Online Safety Week

Planning for online safety week (wk: beginning 6th February) Consider the following questions with classes in our home schools and feedback ideas:

- What online issues really matter to children and young people?
- What changes do they want to see about online safety?
- How can we all work together to help us talk about it?

Notes:

ASJ:

Heath – people don't want to talk about online safety because they don't want everyone in the class to know what is going on.

Madeline: we want to give more time in school to talk about online safety.

Clarke – it's important not to share passwords.

ASI:

Reya – Yes, we said don't share passwords.

Jacob – we want a worry monster in each class to write a note to put in if we have any worries that we don't want to say out loud.

Tommy – don't share your details with strangers

St. Giles:

Joesph: Talk more about online safety and don't keep your worries inside, talk to a teacher or trusted adult or your parents. We want to share top-tips with the classes.

You should only play games that are age-appropriate.

ASJ:

Eliza - In morning work we look at one part of online safety every week.

Zaynep - we do it on a Monday so looking at WhatsApp or learning about BeReal.

Poppy – we want more children's versions of apps on I pads.

Megan – parents can check websites and know that games are safe.

Hannah – we have to be aware of scams and not get scammed.

DCT:

Tamara – we talked about using browsers that are more secure and child friendly; putting ideas in a box and writing things down like questions we have; not telling people our passwords; it's important that you know who you are talking to online.

Henry – it's important to set time aside to talk to adults about games and APPs that might not be age appropriate or get recommendations of games.

St. Giles:

Violet – we think that it's important to spend time talking to parents at home about what we are playing online so that they know.

ASI:

Pippa- we are going to make posters to tell people about being safe online and put them up around school.

Reya – make an e-worry monster for each class to post any worries.

ASJ:

Danny – we are going to make a display with age limits on and adverts for new apps and games, things on that people recommend and a place to post questions about online safety, a chat space.

DCT:

Henry – we are going to have a poster competition to design the best online poster and do a survey of which are the most commonly used games in school.
