Date: 4.11.21	<p>We talked about safety in school. Who can we go to if we are worried? What are playtimes like, do you feel safe? How do you think other children feel?</p> <p>Together we made a survey to send out to all pupils to see how they feel. Can we help? (Pupil Voice)</p>	<p>All questionnaires sent out to classes.</p> <p>Results to be discussed in the next meeting in January.</p> <p>COMPLETED</p>
Date: 20.01.22	<p>We looked through the results from the pupil voice survey. Ambassadors share with more play equipment at playtimes, children are happier.</p> <p>I asked Ambassadors how they think we can help the school. Ambassadors felt keeping clean and washing our hands will help children stay clean and healthy. Ambassadors share they would like to talk to the children in their classes about designing a 'wash hands' poster. The Ambassadors will then vote for one poster per class to be chosen to be laminated and displayed around our school near sink areas.</p>	<p>Children to talk to their class in a PSHE lesson and promote the posters. Selected poster will be displayed around the school.</p> <p>COMPLETED-posters are now placed in classrooms.</p>

<p>Date: 3.03.22</p>	<p>Topics to discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jubilee - Planters and seating to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee. 	<p>We talked about the Queen- What is her name? What does the Queen do? What special event is coming up soon?</p> <p>Children discussed that a bench or a plaque might be nice thing to have in school as it is something we can keep and can remember the Queen's jubilee.</p> <p>Miss Simpson to look at benches and a plaque to be placed at the infant school and discuss with SLT.</p>

<p>Date: 5.11.21</p>	<p>We talked about How to feel safe in school. Who can you go to if you're worried?</p> <p>Who are the people that can help keep us safe at school? Together the children help to put a survey together to see how other children in the junior school feel. The children discussed questions to ask and helped add these to the survey.</p>	<p>All questionnaires sent out to classes.</p> <p>Results to be discussed in the next meeting in January.</p> <p>COMPLETED</p>
<p>Date: 20.01.22</p>	<p>We looked through the results from the pupil voice survey.</p> <p>The Ambassadors discussed playtimes and lunchtimes. They talked about fallout with friends and where to go for support if you had no one to play with.</p> <p>We then talked about a buddy bench or sign that we could make or buy for the playground. The Ambassadors felt this would be a good place to go to so teachers or Ambassador could help children find a friend to play with.</p> <p>We then read through the policy Child Friendly Policy.</p> <p>Views shared by Ambassadors are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *They like the policy and how it looks. *It is easy to follow the numbers and next steps. 	<p>Mrs Lloyd and Yr6 Ambassador to select a friendship sign and ask Mr Clark if we have money to purchase.</p> <p>School Ambassadors to explain the friendship area (and sign) to all children in Collective Worship.</p> <p>COMPLETED- Letter sent to Mr Clark and discussed in collective worship</p> <p>Children feel the policy is a good idea and makes them feel heard and understood.</p>

<p>3.03.22</p>	<p>Topics to discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Toilets at KS2: 2 x 4 cubicles so would like to make unisex • Planters and seating to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee. • Red nose day 	<p>*Toilets Children shared they like the idea of something new and clean and how it could save space having unisex toilets. A year 6 child shared that older child may choose a different gender as they grow, so this idea could help them feel more comfortable being unisex toilets.</p> <p>14 children voted yes- 2 voted no.</p> <p>The children who voted no said they might feel uncomfortable.</p> <p>Suggestions- Have one side for girls and one side boys.</p> <p>Red Nose Day- Agreed own clothes day and bring a pound coin.</p> <p>Jubilee – Discussed with Miss Simpson about having something to keep in school that will remind us of the Queen's jubilee. Suggestions of a quiet area with benches and plants, this to be placed in the playground area for children to use daily. Miss Simpson asked the children to think of fundraising ideas and share in next meeting.</p>
