Share the words at the top of the planning. These are the words God spoke to Joshua when he asked him to become the leader of his people: What do you think he means?

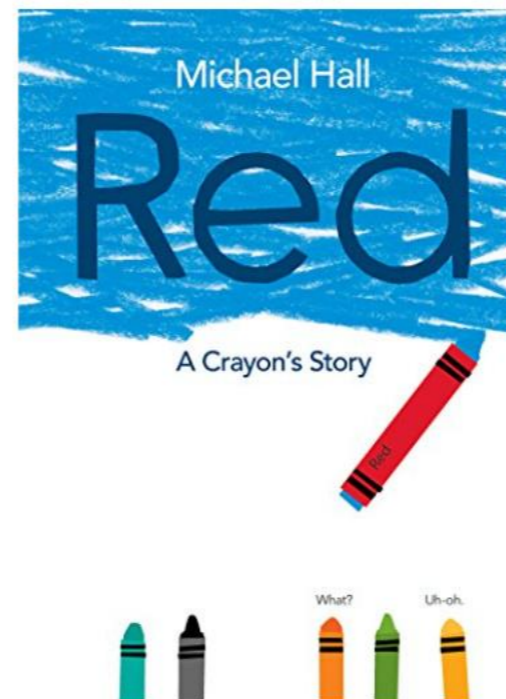


