



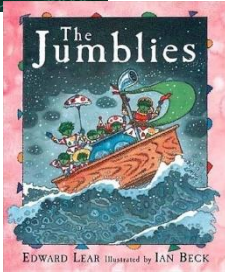
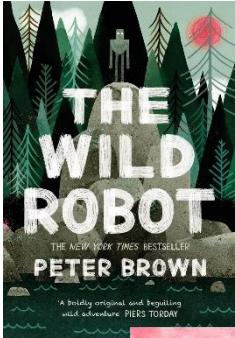

Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. We will be starting with the poem 'The Jumblies' by Edward Lear and exploring its content. We will be composing letters, descriptive stories and reports as well as focusing on continually improving transcription and handwriting. We will continue to complete daily grammar tasks which will include: possessive apostrophes, identifying adjectives, adverbs, nouns and verbs as well as making use of expanded noun phrases. We will also be exploring spelling rules focussing largely on homophones, suffixes and prefixes. We will also be widening our vocabulary by looking at a new word and day and challenging ourselves to include this word in our work.

In Maths we will be continuing work on fractions and moving on to explore decimals. It continues to be very important that your child knows all their times tables up to 12x12 in preparation for their year 4 times table test in June. We will be completing monthly checks to ensure the children feel prepared for the assessment.

Throughout this term, the children will be learning about the Vikings particularly exploring their impact and legacy. We will also be looking at the Norman invasion of 1066. In Science this half term we will be learning all about Living things and their habitats. In RE we will be learning about Salvation in the Easter Story. In our PE lessons we will be focusing on athletics. Rowan class will be enjoying forest school lessons on Wednesdays throughout the term.
