



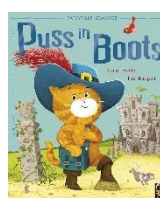
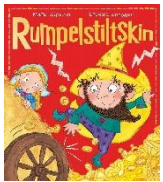
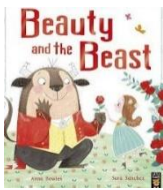

Key Learning this term...

This term our learning will be based around fairy tales. The children will revisit some of their beloved fairy tale stories that they learnt in EYFS and Year 1, as well as some new ones. We will be looking at important grammar features and we will build towards writing our own fairy tales. This term we will be expected to use all the punctuation we have learnt so far, such as full stops, commas, capital letters, apostrophes, question marks and exclamation marks. The children will be encouraged to use their spelling knowledge in their writing. In Maths we will be constantly recapping the four operations (+ - x and ÷) as well as revisiting all prior learned content. We will be exploring measurement; length, height, capacity, mass and temperature. In Geography we'll be focusing on seasonal and daily weather patterns, the drawing of maps, identifying physical and human features and using locational language. Our science topic this term is 'Plants'. This topic will allow the children to explore what plants need to grow.

In PSHE we will be exploring 'Changes'. This will include recognising who can help us when we are affected by change and how to manage big feelings. We will also spend time exploring what it means to be a good friend. In RE we will be thinking about 'What does Easter mean to Christians?'. In D+T we are continuing to look at building stable structures. In Art we are exploring 'Life in Colour' using a range of mixed media.

We are welcoming in some experienced coaches to teach PE this term. We will be working on hitting balls, catching and running. In Computing, we are programming robots.
