Our class texts...



Key Learning this term...

This term Year 3 will be reading the book 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be using this class book to explore and write our own poetry, newspaper reports and letters using appropriate spelling, grammar and punctuation. In Maths, we are continuing to explore multiplication and division before moving on to length and perimeter and finally, fractions.

During our science lessons this term, we will be learning all about forces and magnets. We will name a range of types of magnet and show how the poles attract and repel. In History, we will be comparing present day Matlock to the past and exploring changes over time. We will also be comparing a range of first and second-hand sources, beginning to discuss their reliability. In Geography, we will be looking at maps, symbols and scale. French lessons will continue this term with the children learning how to write and say French numbers. In our Design and Technology lessons, we will be designing and creating a moving toy with a pneumatic system, learning how trapped air can be used to create a product with moving parts. The focus for our PSHE lessons is 'Exploring Emotions' this half term. We will learn about the importance of expressing how we feel and be able to identify a range of strategies that could be used to respond to feelings. In RE our unit of learning is called 'What do different people believe about God?'. We will identify beliefs about God that are held by Christians, Hindus, and Muslims. Service is our new school value for this term so we will be thinking about this in class, around school and in collective worship time. Gymnastics is the focus for our PE sessions this term. We will be creating sequences showing contrasting shapes and balances. In Music, we will be focusing on the four key musical words of pitch, tempo, timbre and dynamics. We will identify and play C, D and E on the glockenspiel and be able to identify the notes on a staff. Finally, in Computing, we will be using block-based programming language using Scratch.
