

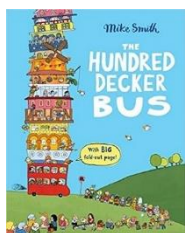

Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'travel and transport'. We are looking forward to learning about transport old and new, capital cities in the UK and different types of materials.

In Phonics we will continue to use Little Wandle to ensure our children can read fluently and with prosody and understanding. This term we will continue to learn our Phase 5 sounds and tricky words. Your child will receive their new Little Wandle reading book each week. Please encourage your child to read at home with you using their fabulous prosody (special reading voice!)

In Literacy we will be working on using the correct grammar in our writing and we will be even including some compound words. We will be writing postcards, rhyming stories and recounts.

In Maths we will be looking at place value to 50, counting in 10's and measuring length, height, mass and capacity.

In History we will be learning about older types of transport (trams, steam trains, planes, cars).

In Geography we will be learning how the UK is made up of four countries and be able to find these on a map. We will also be comparing the landscape and features of the four countries of the UK.

In Science we will be learning about different materials and predicting whether they can float or sink.

In PSHE we will be learning about 'being healthy while in PE will we be learning how to hit, catch and run with a ball. In RE we will be learning about incarnation.
