



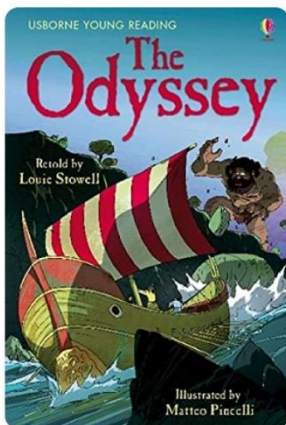
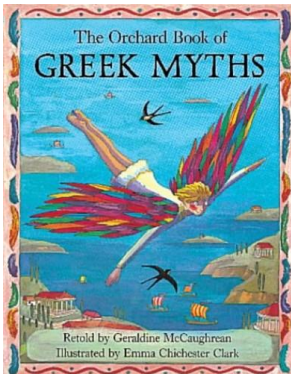

## Key Learning this term...
