



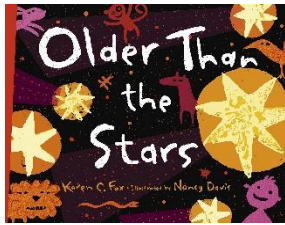
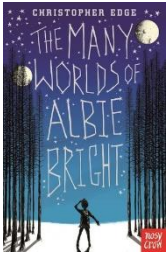

Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'The Many Worlds of Albie Bright'. We will be writing a biography on Stephen Hawking and a narrative. We will also be exploring poetry and writing our own poems based on the poem "wings" by Pie Corbett.
