



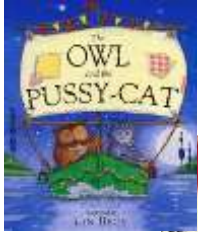

Key Learning this term...

As the evenings get darker and the days get colder, Year 2 will be learning about all things magical and nocturnal. Our topic this term is 'Magic!' We'll be exploring stories by Oliver Jeffers, Julia Donaldson, Charles Dickens and Benji Davies, as well as a classic poem. The children will use these texts to improve their writing even further, practising what they have already been taught in writing, and adding additional knowledge and understanding.

In maths we are continuing to consolidate our understanding of addition and subtraction, with 2 digit numbers, as well as beginning new topics such as shape. We will continue to practise our 2x, 5x and 10x tables as well as our number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.

In DT we will be learning a simple running stitch and using this to make some spooky ghost puppets. In Science we will be learning about materials and comparing the suitability of these everyday materials. In History we will learn about the Gunpowder plot, as well as travelling back to the Victorian times to explore the difference between life today and life then. In Geography, we will be thinking about Fieldwork skills and focusing on how to use and read maps. Linking to this, our art topic is called 'Map it Out'. We will be creating a piece of art that represents our local area using a map as their stimulus. The children will learn three techniques for working creatively with materials. In RE, we will be focusing on 'What does Christmas mean to Christians' and in PSHE we will be exploring the topic 'Being Me'. In PE this term we are focusing on dance and how we can transition from shapes and balances.
