



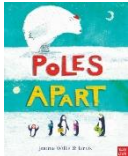

These words are identified as part of our weekly story time and are known as 'golden words'. How many ways can you use them at home? What do they mean?



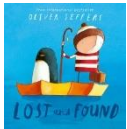

### Key Learning this term...

Thank you for all your support in enabling the children to settle during their first term at school. The children have made a fabulous start to their first year at school and we have loved watching them grow in confidence!

This term our topic is '**Winter Wonderland**'. The children have enjoyed playing with the small world snow scene and rowing a boat through icy waters outside!

In **Maths** this term we are comparing numbers up to 5. We will be finding 1 more and 1 less of numbers and learning our number bonds to 5. We will also look at space, ensuring the children are able to use positional language correctly. We will also begin to look at numbers to 10.

In **Literacy** we are focusing on writing labels, lists and captions. We will also begin to look at how to create sentences and captions, using a capital letter and full stop. Towards the end of the term we will be writing some letters to Santa!

In some of our other topic areas we are:

**Communication & Language:** We will continue to develop our communication and language skills through areas such as our role play and small world. We will continue to look at and share stories and will visit our school library. We will also share and discuss our favourite stories with our friends.

**Physical Development:** We will be using the large outdoor equipment to strengthen our bodies! We will also develop our fine motor skills with activities such as weaving. We will continue to have access to the scooters to help develop balance and coordination, we will be negotiating obstacle courses.

**Personal, Social & Emotional Development:** We will be continuing to practise sharing and learning how we are all different. We will also celebrate Friendship week!

Some other activities we will be completing this term are: making Christmas decorations using salt dough, learning songs and actions for our nativity, going for an Autumn walk and visiting the pantomime! In circle times we will be celebrating differences. In RE we will be learning about Christmas and the Nativity Story.

### Reminders...

This term in the children's homework books we will be sticking in a *phonics overview* recapping the taught learning of the week (as discussed at parents evening). Please make sure your child's homework book is in their bag every Wednesday ready for us to stamp & add in a new sheet. Thank you!

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, they will have 2 books each week (a decodable phonics reading book and a sharing book for you to read to them and enjoy together).

Water bottles are sent home on Friday and brought back on Monday.

PE kits should be in school at all times. PE will be every Wednesday. They will come home at the end of the half term for a wash!

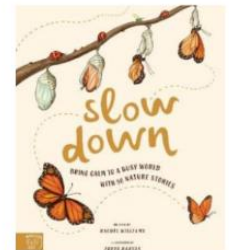
Free fruit is provided for all children every day, if you choose to bring a snack please ensure it is fruit or vegetables in a named, reusable container.
