Key Learning this term...

This term Year 6 are beginning the year with a topic on The Victorians and The Industrial Revolution!

We'll be exploring the novel of *Oliver Twist* as well as enjoying reading *Holes*. We have numerous non-fiction books about the Victorians and we will be studying a poem by W H Auden and others. The children will use these texts to further understand the Victorian era and embed the writing structures of classical texts.

In Maths we are consolidating our knowledge of place value and ordering and comparing numbers up to 10,000,000. The children will then continue to develop their understanding of calculating in all four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Through History, we will learn about the industrial revolution and how it's impacted on society today. In Science, we will learn about electricity and will carry out some scientific enquiries. In Geography, we will extend our understanding of the industrial revolution through looking at the British Empire. In PSHE we will be focusing on 'Being ME' and identifying similarities and differences amongst people in society and what makes us unique.

We are also reflecting on our value of compassion this half term and in RE we will be focusing on Creation and why some people believe God exists.
