



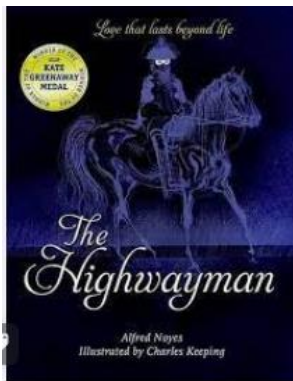
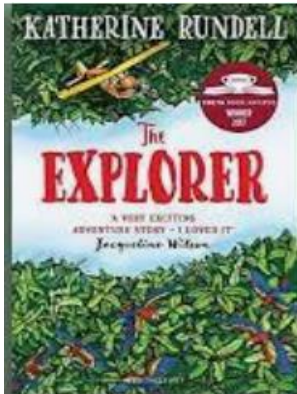

Key Learning this term...

This term, All Saints' will be reflecting on the value of **Compassion** in classrooms and in Collective worship.

Literacy: We will be debating and writing a balanced argument about whether we should be able to tell the Brazilian government how best to tackle rainforest deforestation; writing a newspaper and an information text. All of our work will relate to our class book: *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundell. We will also be studying *The Highwayman* by Alfred Noyes for this term's poetry focus.

Maths: We will focus on Place value and then move on to addition and subtraction.

Science: Our topic is 'Forces' this term

Geography: We will be learning about world rivers and building on our knowledge on river features from Y4.

RE: Our area of focus this term is called: People of God.

DT: In our Design and technology lessons this term we will be designing and making a pop up book.

Art: This Unit is named: 'Sculpture – interactive installation' and the children will be investigating the effect of scale and space on 3D sculpture as well as having a go at constructing their own 3D sculpture.

PE: Swimming. The PE this term will be down at the Arc. Please look out for the form on Parent mail.

PSHE: Difference and diversity. We will also have regular circle times in the classroom.

Spelling test: We will be giving out weekly spelling lists on Monday and will test on a Friday Morning. Please help your child to learn the spelling words at home.

Homework: Our homework will be set on a Wednesday and then looked at in class the following Wednesday. Please note that in Year 5, the children have two CGP homework books: Maths and English. Children should be self-marking their work after finishing and using the answers to help with questions that they found tricky. We will go through the homework with the children in school and help with any issues or misconceptions they have had.
