Key Learning this term...

This term Year 1 are kicking off the year with our Beary Fun Topic; 'Bears Bears Everywhere!' We'll be enjoying reading lots of great 'bear stories' to inspire our writing. In literacy, we will focus on forming our letters beautifully and punctuating our sentences correctly.

In Phonics we will continue to use Little Wandle to ensure our children can read fluently and with prosody and understanding. This term we will revisit Phase 3 sounds before moving on to Phase 4. Your child will receive their new Little Wandle reading book this week. Please encourage your child to read at home. Thank you 😊

In Maths we will be looking at place value to 10. We will be counting one more and one less than a number given to 10 and counting back from 10.

In History we will be learning about old and new things, focusing on the history of the teddy bear. In Geography we will be learning how to record weather patterns using a weather chart. In Science we will be learning about the seasons, focusing on the changes to plants and weather in Autumn.

In PSHE we will be thinking about our feelings and the feelings of others. In RE we will be learning about The Creation and we will think about what we are thankful for. In PE we will be focussing on gymnastics! We will be doing lots of balancing, stretching and jumping.

In Art we will be mark making with different media and drawing from observation.

Reminders...

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, with their reading book.

Water bottles are brought to school on Monday and sent home on Friday. Please make sure that there is only water in your bottle, and they are in school at the beginning of each week.

PE kits should be in school at all times. They will come home at the end of the half term for a wash.
