

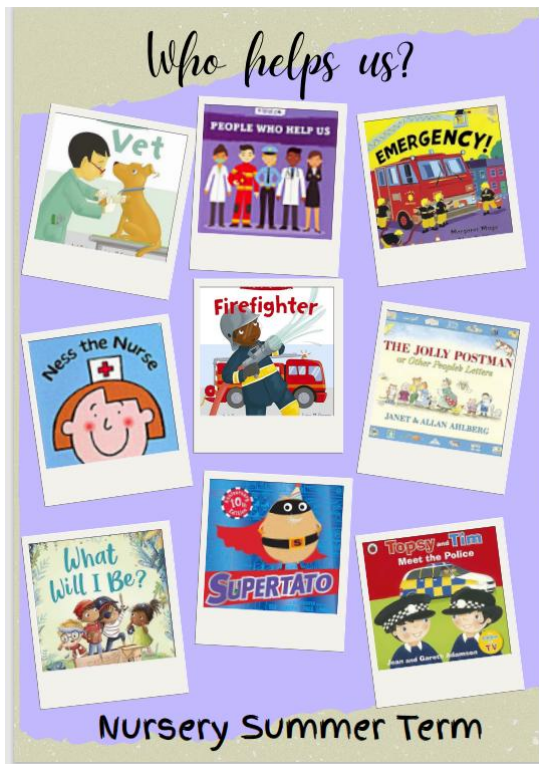

## Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Who helps us?' where we will look at a different occupation each week and see how they help us, we are starting with Firefighters, moving on to learning about Police Officers, Vets, Doctors, Nurses and Post people. We will enjoy lots of wonderful stories to read and share together along this theme. Each week we will continue to learn a new Nursery Rhyme during Rhyme Time. We continue to have daily Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle sessions which is our early writing programme and dough disco which strengthens our fine and gross motor skills. We have daily phonics sessions following the Little Wandle phonics scheme. We will tune into sounds and play oral blending games.

In Maths this term we are learning to make patterns and join in with repeats in songs, patterns and rhymes in stories. We will also match shapes, solve simple puzzles including jigsaws and carry-on repeating AB patterns. We will continue to learn to subitise to 3 and count and recognise amounts to 5.

Other areas of learning this term will be:

- learning to write our own names
- hold scissors with increasing control and make snips

## Reminders...

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, with their sharing book, we aim to change these at least once a week in the school library.

Please ensure your child has a water bottle, change of clothes, wellington boots and a coat in school each day.
