Welcome back — we hope you have all had a lovely Easter holiday.

Key Learning this term...

This term we have lots more exciting opportunities planned across the curriculum. Our new class book is called 'The Boy who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd. We will be using this book to explore and write our own poetry, discussion text and narrative using appropriate spelling, grammar and punctuation. In Maths, we will be completing another unit of fractions including finding fractions of a number. During our science lessons this term, we will be learning all about the parts of a plant and their different functions. In History, we will be looking at how something that has happened in the past has had an effect on people's lives today. In Geography, we will be focusing on fieldwork. We will be learning how to navigate a map using 8-point compass points and 4-point grid references. We will also have a go at orienteering.

The focus for our PSHE lessons is 'being responsible' this half term. We will be looking at rights and responsibilities towards each other and the planet. In RE our unit of learning is called 'What do different people believe about God?' where we will be exploring this through different viewpoints. In Music, we are focusing on composition. We will be building upon our athletics skills (jumping, throwing and running) getting ready for sports day in PE. In Computing, we will be looking at desktop publishing by creating documents, copy and pasting images, looking at different page layouts and much more! Finally, in Art we will be exploring sculpture and abstract art.

PE kits should be in school at all times. Our PE day is Thursday.

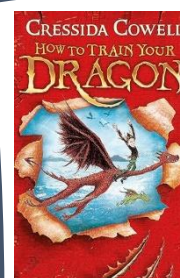
If you choose to bring in a snack, please ensure it is fruit or vegetables. No nuts please 😊
