



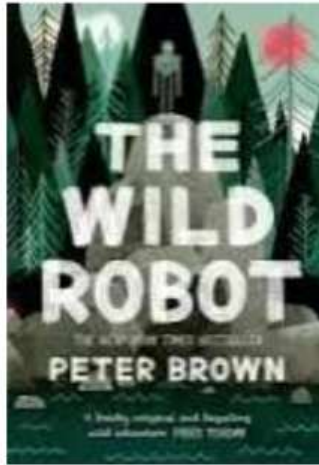

Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will continue to be based around the book 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. We will be writing a non-chronological report, a diary and finally a narrative based on the Wild Robot. We will continue to complete daily grammar tasks which will include: possessive apostrophes and identifying the difference between plural and possessive nouns; writing and punctuating direct speech. We will also be exploring spelling rules focussing on: suffix ing, ly, prefix inter, "ture" words and "ous" words. We will also be widening our vocabulary by looking at new words and challenging ourselves to include these words in our work.

In Maths we will be continuing work on fractions and decimals. This will lead into working with money, shape and statistics. It continues to be very important that your child knows all their times tables up to 12x12 in preparation for their year 4 times table test in June, we will be completing regular checks to ensure the children feel prepared for the assessment.

Throughout this term, the children will be learning about rivers across the world, and closer to home, with the Derwent.

In Science this half term we will be learning all about sound and how it travels.

In RE we will be learning about the Holy spirit and Pentecost answering the question, 'When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?'

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on athletics and preparing for our sports day activities.

In DT we will be designing and building pavilions looking at frame structures.

We will be continuing with our ukulele lessons this half term in music building on the work we did last half term.

Reminders...

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, with their reading book and diary to use in school.

Homework will be sent out every Wednesday to be handed in the following Tuesday.

Water bottles should be brought to school on Monday and sent home on Friday. Please make sure that there is only water in your bottle, and they are in school at the beginning of each week.
