We currently have one place available, and the role lasts for four years. You can put yourself forward, or nominate another parent, as long as they are happy to stand.

What does the Local Trust Committee do?

The Local Trust Committee supports and challenges the work of both schools. Our children and staff are very fortunate to benefit from their time, commitment and care. The committee's work includes:

- Making sure pupils are doing well
- Listening to parents and the wider community
- Safeguarding and pupil wellbeing
- Supporting children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND)
- Keeping an eye on finances
- Supporting the school's Christian ethos

Who can apply?

You can apply if you are a parent or carer of a child at either All Saints CE Infant School or All Saints CE Junior School.

You do not need any special qualifications or previous experience. Full training and support will be provided.
