Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'What lives under the sea?' We will enjoy lots of wonderful stories to read and share together along this theme. Each week we will continue to learn a new Nursery Rhyme during Rhyme Time. We continue to have daily Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle sessions which is our early writing programme and dough disco which strengthens our fine and gross motor skills. We have daily phonics sessions following the Little Wandle phonics scheme. We will tune into sounds and play oral blending games.

In Maths this term we are learning to join in with repeats in songs, patterns and rhymes in stories. We will look in more detail at repeating patterns, progressing to creating their own AB pattern and will begin to notice an error. We will continue to learn to subitise to 3 and count and recognise amounts to 5, order numbers to 5 and match numerals.

Other areas of learning this term will be:

- learning to write our own names
- hold scissors with increasing control and make snips
- make finger patterns and digit isolation activities eg. Showing 3 fingers or counting 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 using fingers.
- developing upper body/lower body strength to complete obstacle courses, crawl through tunnels, weave, move through hoops.
- keep a beat in music and use instruments

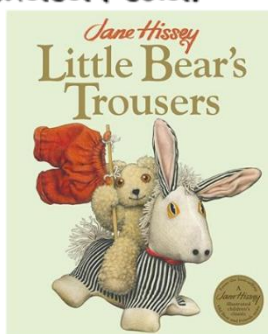
