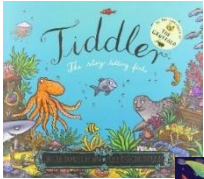

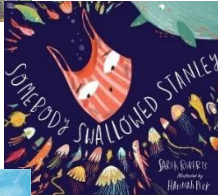
Our class texts...

Key Learning this term...

Our topic this term is 'Under the Sea'. We will be thinking of beach holidays and sunny get-aways, as well as pirates and sea life!

In **Maths** this term we will be consolidating our understanding of number, as well as spending time learning about sorting, shape, measures and time.

In **Literacy** we will be reading the texts on the left and producing longer pieces of writing inspired by them as well as reading poetry. We are following phase 4 within the Little Wandle programme and continue our reading sessions three times a week.

In some of our other topic areas we are:

- Riding the balance bikes on a course and trying to keep our balance whilst lifting our feet to go faster. We are learning to steer with accuracy.
- Practising controlling and moving objects like balls and recognising the difference between actions such as moving softly, powerfully.
- Relating body movements to music.
- Developing a sense of beat, playing instruments by shaking, tapping and scraping.
- Using running stitch to make a simple teddy bear.
- Learning what a well-dressing is and decorating it collaboratively.
- Learning about a variety of animal habitats
- Exploring floating and sinking experimenting with objects
- Comparing a town to a city and the UK to Japan.
