



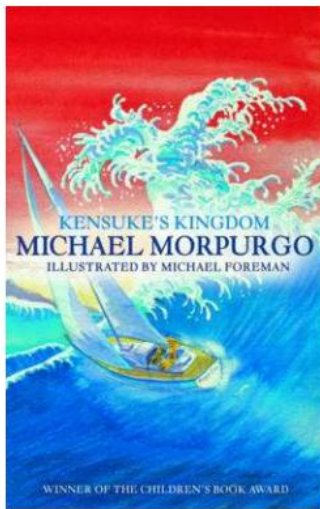

## Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be using this book to explore a range of genres including narratives. The children will also be learning and applying English grammar concepts such as word classes and a wide range of punctuation.

In Maths we will be exploring angles, money, shape and space and data handling.

Throughout this term, we will be focussing on Geography and looking at map and field work.

In Science this half term we will be learning all about taking good care of the environment through our conservation topic.

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on Rounders.

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, with their reading book and diary to use in school.

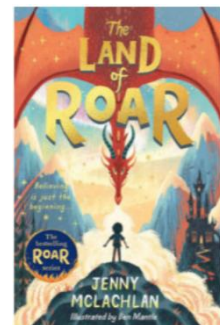
Homework will be sent out every Wednesday to be handed in the following Tuesday.
