



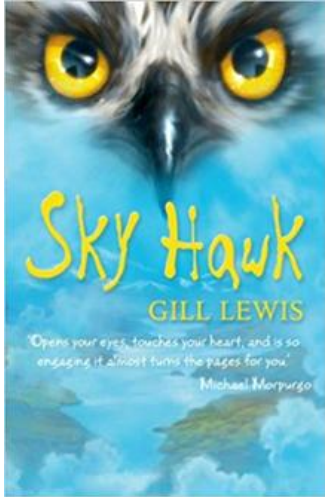

## Key Learning this term...

**English:** Using the lovely text, Sky Hawk, our writing opportunities this term are: an information text, Newspaper, Monologue, and Book review along with Poetry: The Eagle by Alfred Lord Tennyson.

**Maths:** We will be learning about angles and reflection before relooking at decimals and moving on to Negative numbers, Converting between units of measurement and finally Volume.
