



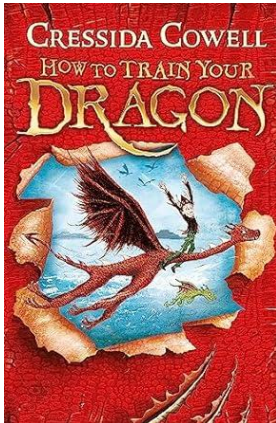

Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'How to train your dragon' by Cressida Cowell. We will be writing narrative; instruction; explanation and kenning poems. We will continue to complete daily grammar tasks which will include: fronted adverbials; complex sentences; identifying adjectives; adverbs; nouns and verbs. We will also be exploring spelling rules focussing on: suffixes cian, tion, sure, sion and prefixes super, sub and mis.

In Maths we will be exploring multiplication and fractions. It is very important that your child knows all their times tables up to 12x12 in preparation for their year 4 times table test in June.

Throughout this term, the children will be learning about the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings particularly exploring their impact and legacy.

In Science this half term we will be learning all about Living things including the digestive system and teeth.

In RE we will be learning about why people of different faiths pray, and some prayer practices in different faith groups. French will be about numbers and dates and Art is all about colour. In computing the children will learn how to move a Turtle around the screen.

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on invasion games such as Hockey. Due to Forest Schools being on Wednesday, **Larch class will be having PE on Monday.**
