Relationship and Sex Education consultation

Thank you to the 117 parents who completed our recent RSHE survey. The consultation showed strong confidence in our provision, with:

- **82%** agreeing that the school provides appropriate education about relationships.
- **85%** agreeing that the content taught is age appropriate.
- **91%** agreeing that RSHE helps children stay safe.
- **89%** feeling confident in the school's approach to RSHE.
- **96%** agreeing that children should receive sex education in a sensitive and age-appropriate way.

Parents particularly valued our focus on respectful relationships, personal safety, emotional wellbeing and growing up. Many also requested additional resources to help support conversations at home. We are grateful for your feedback and will use your suggestions to further strengthen our provision.
