



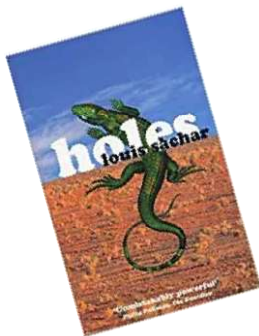

Key Learning this term...

This term Year 6 are beginning the year with a topic on The Victorians!

We'll be exploring the novels: *The Railway Children*, *Oliver Twist* and *Peter Pan* as well as enjoying reading *Holes* and *The Boy Who Swam with Piranha's* as part of our *Reading for Pleasure* time. We have numerous non-fiction books about the Victorians and we will be studying a poem by W H Auden and others. The children will use these texts to further understand the Victorian era and embed the writing structures of classical texts.

In Maths we are consolidating our knowledge of place value and ordering and comparing numbers up to 10,000,000. The children will then continue to develop their understanding of calculating in all four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Through History, Geography and Science lessons, we will learn about the industrial revolution and how it's impacted on society today. We will also learn about electricity and will carry out some scientific enquiries. In Geography, we will extend our understanding of the industrial revolution through looking at the British Empire.
