Key Learning this term...

This term we will be learning all about space! The children will read and learn from some texts about space which focus on real historical events, as well as fiction books based in space. As an exciting extension of our space topic, the children will visit the National Space Centre! This aims to inspire and motivate the children in their learning this term and answer any questions they may have.

In Literacy we will use the key texts as stimuli to write recounts, Sci-Fi stories and writing for a range of purposes. Within the children's writing they will be expected to use the full range of punctuation taught so far; capital letters, full stops, commas, apostrophes for contraction, exclamation marks and question marks. We have and will continue to explore vocabulary, understanding and using nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs. In Maths this term we will cover, money and then multiplication and division. We will also keep practising our fluency in areas such as addition and subtraction.

Our History lessons will follow our Space theme and focus on significant historical events such as the first moon landing in 1969 and more recent astronauts in space. In Geography we will explore and learn about the planets in the solar system, focusing on the features of our planet Earth. In Science, we will be focusing on living things and their habitats. In Art we will be mixing colours using paint and mixed media. In Design and Technology, we will be looking at making sturdy structures including making a chair for baby bear. RE will enable the children to think about what makes certain places are sacred. In music, we are working towards our exciting singing performance (more information to follow!) and are starting singing lessons on Tuesdays!
