Which dinosaur is the biggest?



Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is Dinosaurs and we are exploring the enquiry question 'Which dinosaur is the biggest?' where we have lots of wonderful stories to read and share together. Each week we will continue to learn a new Nursery Rhyme during Rhyme Time and revisit some of our earlier songs. We continue to have daily Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle sessions which is our early writing programme and dough disco which strengthens our fine and gross motor skills. We will have daily phonics sessions following the Little Wandle phonics scheme and this term we are focusing on the sounds: **d g o c k e**. We will tune into sounds and play oral blending games and identify words that begin with these initial sounds.

In Maths this term we are learning to make and describe simple patterns and take/give 1,2 and 3 objects.

Other areas of learning this term will be:

- making purposeful marks and describing meaning
- holding and aiming to catch items in hands
- listen to a range of stories and be able to retell a familiar story
- use a range of tools for a purpose

Reminders...

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, with their sharing book, we aim to change these at least once a week in the school library.

Please ensure your child has a water bottle, change of clothes, wellington boots and a warm coat in school each day. Now it is cold a pair of gloves/mittens, hat and scarf would also be good as we do like to go out in all weathers.

Polite reminder that no toys are to be in school.

A selection of cereal, cheese, fruit and vegetables are provided in a morning and afternoon for snack along with milk or water.
