



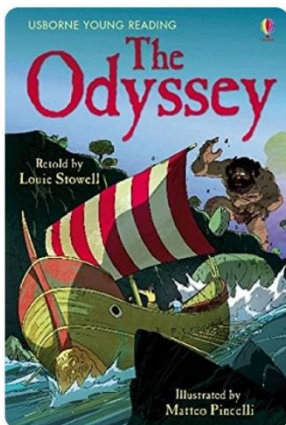
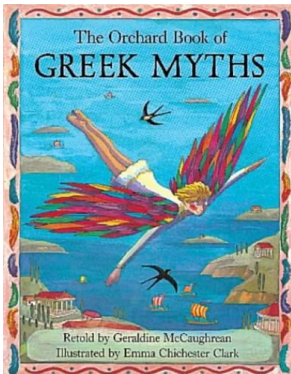

Key Learning this term...

Literacy: We will be learning about the Ancient Greeks in History this term and this will also be the focus for our Literacy lessons. The children will be writing diaries, information texts, blogging and a myth. Our poetry this term will be based on *The Tyger* by William Blake as well as the *Highway Man* by Alfred Noyes.

Maths: We will be moving onto multiplication and division, and fractions. Keep those times-tables sharp as they will be needed on daily basis.

Science: Our topic this term will be properties of materials.

Geography: We will be looking at mountains around the world and their features.

RE: Our area of focus this term asks: Was Jesus the Messiah?

D&T: This term's unit will investigate food from farm to plate and in ART we will study architecture drawings and the artist Hundertwasser.
