

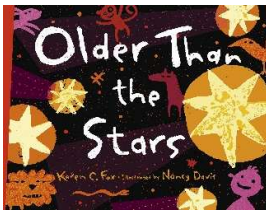
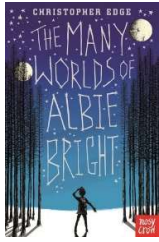

## Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'The Many Worlds of Albie Bright'. We will be writing a non-chronological report and a narrative. We will also be exploring poetry and writing our own poems.

In Maths we will be exploring perimeter before beginning our multiplication and division units. We will continue to develop our times tables recall, regular time on TTR at home will support this too!

Throughout Geography this half term we will be exploring counties and regions in the United Kingdom. We will also be using atlases to locate and name key rivers.

In Science this half term we will be learning all about states of matter and the large Hadron Collider!

In our PE lessons we will be focusing on gymnastics. We will also be learning about the Holy Trinity and prayer in RE.
