Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Why do leaves go crispy?' where we have lots of wonderful stories to read and share together. Each week we will continue to learn a new Nursery Rhyme during Rhyme Time. We continue to have daily Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle sessions which is our early writing programme and dough disco which strengthens our fine and gross motor skills. We have now begun daily phonics sessions following the Little Wandle phonics scheme. We will tune into sounds and play oral blending games.

In Maths this term we are learning to know: subitise 1-3 and recognise numbers 1 to 3.

Other areas of learning this term will be:

- Developing awareness of uniqueness and diversity
- Recognising and using of names (teachers and friends)
- Take part in a range of cultural religious and community events and experiences.
- Respond by moving their whole bodies to sounds they enjoy e.g. music or a regular beat.
