



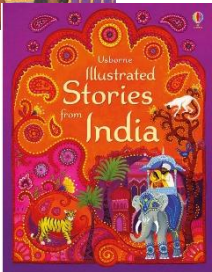
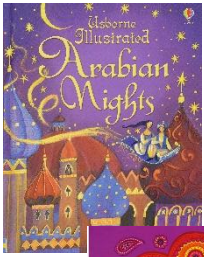

Key Learning this term...

Welcome to Year 4!

In this first term Year 4 are kicking off the year with a topic all about the Early Islamic civilisation! During our English lessons, we will be exploring stories from 'The Thousand and One Nights'. From the adventures of Sinbad and Aladdin to tales of genies and magical lands!

In Maths our first unit is Place Value. We will be exploring 4-digit numbers, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 before moving on to addition and subtraction using the 4-digit numbers we have learnt about.

Through History and Geography, we will learn about the Early Islamic civilisation and the importance of Baghdad. We will explore the House of Wisdom, the Silk Route and how people lived. In Science this half term we will be learning all about electricity and circuits, creating our own and exploring insulating and conducting materials. In D and T, we will be using our skills and knowledge to design and make a torch.

In our PE lessons - on Thursdays- we will be focusing on athletics with the help of Rural Derbyshire! We will also be learning about Creation in RE and in PSHE we will be recognising how to make informed choices and understanding different attitudes to risk through a topic on drug education.

In Computing, we will be applying our knowledge and understanding of networks and in French we will be doing a topic called 'Portraits' learning different adjectives to describe.
