



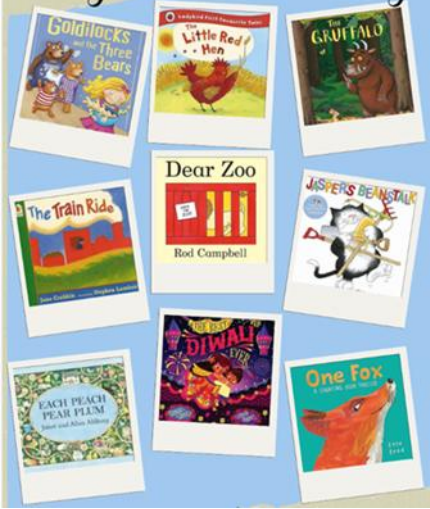

Key Learning this term...

Welcome to Little Acorns Nursery! We are loving getting to know all your wonderful children. Thank you for your patience and support at drop off and pick up, as we continue to get to know yourselves and the children! This term our topic is 'Will you read me a story?' where we have lots of wonderful stories to read and share together. Each week we will learn a new Nursery Rhyme during Rhyme Time. We have started the term with Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle our early writing programme that develops and strengthens fine and gross motor skills by dancing and mark making.

In **Maths** this term we are learning to know: more than, fewer than, same for objects and amounts, hear and say number names and begin to order number names.

Communication & Language: We will have stories with our friends and engage in role play. Other areas of learning this term will be:

- Becoming confident with separation from parent/carer
- Developing engagement in play with adult support
- Creating emerging friendships
- Developing awareness of uniqueness and diversity
- Recognising and using of names (teachers and friends)
- Independently using wheeled vehicles
- Joining in with repeated songs and actions
- Hearing initial and final sounds in words
- Mixing varied materials
- Using of a range of tools
- Development of upper body strength by hanging, climbing, brushing, painting and rolling large objects.

Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies and a coat in school each day.

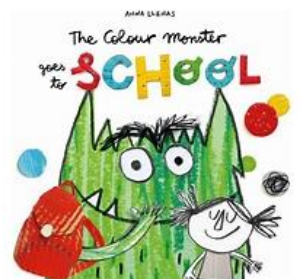
Please name all school uniform.
