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Transition Sessions – Supporting a Smooth Move

To help all children feel confident and excited about the year ahead, we will be holding a series of **transition sessions** during the final weeks of term. These sessions are designed to give children the opportunity to:

- ☀ Spend time in their **new classrooms**
- ☀ Meet their **new teachers and support staff**
- ☀ Explore new routines and expectations in a gentle, supportive way
- ☀ Ask questions and share any thoughts or feelings

We know that change can bring a mix of emotions, and our aim is to make this transition as positive and reassuring as possible for every child.

All Saints' Transition AFTERNOON - Tuesday 1st July:

ALL children should be dropped off as NORMAL.

New starters to EYFS should arrive at 1.30pm for a 'Stay and Play' session.

Children currently in Year 2 will be walked up to the Juniors by staff after lunch.

ALL children will be dismissed at the end of the school day from their NEW classrooms.

Children attending Twilight will be walked back to the Infant school by a member of staff.

All Saints' Transition MORNING - Wednesday 9th July:

ALL children should be dropped off at their NEW classrooms (including current Year 2 and new EYFS starters).

Children currently in Year 2 will be walked back to the Infant school by staff in time for lunch.

New starters in EYFS should be collected at 11.30am.

ALL children should be collected from their CURRENT classrooms at the end of the day.



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Meet the teacher

As always, there will be an opportunity for you to come into school for our planned 'Meet the Teacher' sessions. This is chance to visit your child's classroom, see where they sit and meet your child's teacher. During the session your child's teacher will be around to talk to you about the school year ahead and share some slides about what it's like to be in their class. Both schools will be open to allow an earlier and a later visit on both evenings.
