



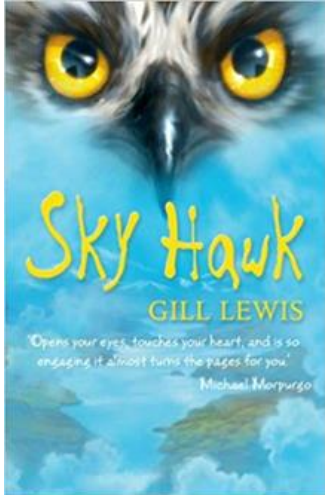

Key Learning this term...

English: Using the lovely text, Sky Hawk, our writing opportunities this term are: Persuasive poster, Newspaper, Monologue, Book review, Poetry: Eagle by Alfred Lord Tennyson.
