Key Learning this term...

In the final term at the Infant School, Year 2 will be learning all about 'Wonderful Women'. Each week we will discover a woman who changed the world or achieved something amazing. These women are our real-life superheroes. Some of the amazing women we will be learning about are:

- Rosa Parks: how she changed history.
- Emeline Pankhurst and Emily Davison: their fight for women's rights.
- Jane Goodall: how she connected with animals.
- Greta Thunberg: how we as young people can help save the environment.
- Mary Anning: how she made geological discoveries.

Our writing will focus on these individuals, concentrating on the spelling, grammar and punctuation that we have been learning about. Now that we are getting ready for Year 3, we will be developing our skills of writing at length, for a purpose and applying all the skills learnt this year. We also are continuing to use cursive or joined handwriting, ensuring all letters are of relative size to one another. We will be looking at poetry, suffixes, possessive apostrophes and writing using the four sentence types. Maths this term focuses on position and direction as well as statistics. Throughout the term we will be placing an emphasis on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. As always, our maths lesson format will begin with a 5 in 5 to develop fluency skills.

In History, we will focus on the wonderful women and reasons for their significance. In Geography we will be developing field work and maths skills. In Design and Technology, we will be working to design our own healthy wrap. In PE we are focusing on 'send and return' and athletics in preparation for sports day. RE will focus on sacred books and the significance of them. In science we will be looking at life cycles of humans and animals and explore each stage of life. Our Music, Dance, Drama and ICT will be covered with the work we are putting in towards our Infant leavers show: There's a sunflower in my supper.

As we are working towards a big transition to the Junior school, our PSHE curriculum will focus on 'growing up' and 'Changes', lending itself to conversation around 'What comes next?' in our school journey.
