## Key Learning this term...

This term our new topic is 'all about me'. We are looking forward to learning about our families and Matlock as well as how to look after our bodies.

In Phonics we will continue to use Little Wandle to ensure our children can read fluently and with prosody and understanding. This term we will continue to recap all the sounds and tricky words we have learnt and continue looking at alien words. After the phonics screening assessment, we will be moving on to new learning. Your child will receive their new Little Wandle reading book and their chosen sharing book each week. During phonics screening week your child will not receive a new Little Wandle book.

In Literacy we will complete work based on a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will learn to write instructions and spell words with the prefix 'un' and suffixes 'ing' 'ed' 'er' and 'est' as well as consolidating our understanding of how to punctuate different types of sentences. We will continue to perfect our pre-cursive handwriting and use conjunctions to extend our sentences.

In Maths we will be looking at fractions, position and direction, money and time and working with numbers to 100.

In History we will be learning about our family's history and the history of Matlock. In Science we will be learning more about the human body, the Eat Well Plate and where our food comes from. In Art and design we will be using fabric to make our own puppets. In DT we will be making fruit smoothies.

In PSHE we will be learning about changes and in RE we will continue to look at Christianity and Islam and think about how we can care for our world.

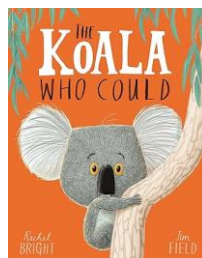
