



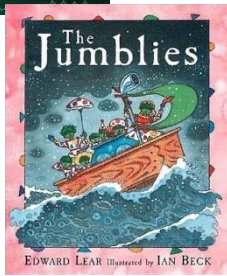
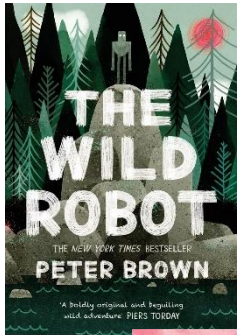

Key Learning this term...

This half term our English work will be based around the book 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. We will be starting with the poem 'The Jumblies' by Edward Lear and exploring its content. We will be composing letters, descriptive stories and reports as well as focusing on continually improving transcription and handwriting. We will continue to complete daily grammar tasks which will include: possessive apostrophes, identifying adjectives, adverbs, nouns and verbs as well as making use of expanded noun phrases. We will also be exploring spelling rules focussing largely on homophones, suffixes and prefixes.

In Maths we will be continuing work on fractions and moving on to explore decimals. It continues to be very important that your child knows all their times tables up to 12x12 in preparation for their year 4 times table test in June. We will be completing monthly checks to ensure the children feel prepared for the assessment.

Throughout this term, the children will be learning about the Vikings particularly exploring their impact and legacy. We will also be looking at the Norman invasion of 1066. In Science this half term we will be learning all about Living things and their habitats. In RE we will be learning about Lent and Salvation. In our PE lessons we will be focusing on tennis. Computing is looking at data. French is learning about the weather.

Rowan class will be enjoying forest school lessons on Fridays throughout the term.
