



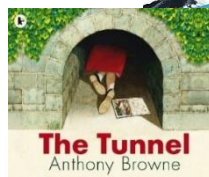

Our value this term is 'perseverance'. We will be exploring this value during our daily collective worship.

Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Explorers!'. In Literacy, we will be covering different types of sentences, adjectives, nouns, verbs and adverbs. We will also be learning about grammatical features such as commas, as well as increasing our descriptive writing ability using expanded noun phrases. We will use this knowledge to write our own adventure stories, diaries and letters. In maths this term, we will be focusing on fractions. We will be learning to recognise halves, quarters, thirds and thinking about equivalent fractions. We will then move on to learning to tell the time to the hour and half hour, quarter to and quarter past. We will extend the children's learning to tell the time to 5-minute intervals.

In Art we will be working with clay and applying the skills we learn to make a clay house. In D+T we will be making structures for a purpose, and thinking about how to make these stronger. In History, we will use the Titanic as a stimulus to answer key historical questions and communicate ideas about events from the past. We will compare several different explorers to ones we have previously learned about. In Geography we will study the human and physical geography of a small area in the UK and compare this to a contrasting, non-European country. In computing we will be creating media and digital music. In Science, we will be exploring the life cycles of plants and experimenting what a seed needs to survive. Furthermore, we will be observing and recording the growth of plants overtime. In PE we are teaching a topic called 'Send and Return'. This will be exploring ball skills and attacking and defending. In Music we are thinking about classical music. In RE, we are thinking about the good news that Jesus brings and thinking about what it means to belong to a faith community. To further explore the Islamic faith and learn about Islamic celebration, we are fortunate to have a workshop led by Derby open centre who will be coming to our school this term. In PSHE we are going to be exploring the idea of money, how it's obtained, how we keep it safe and how it can be used.

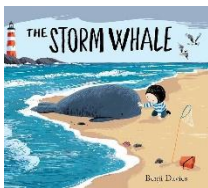
