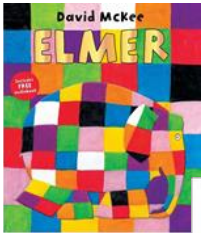

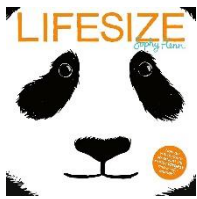
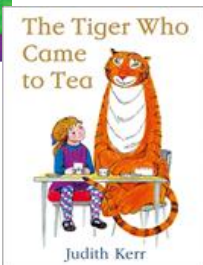
Our class texts...

Key Learning this term...

We have returned after the Easter holidays eager and ready to learn about our new topic which is 'On Safari'. We have many exciting activities planned including our animal adoption centre and safari hut!

In **Maths** this term we will be extending our number knowledge by looking at numbers to 20! We will also be practising our addition and subtraction skills by using number tracks to count on and count back.

In **Literacy** we will be reading some classic animal stories and writing in different styles, including non-fiction. We will also be pushing ourselves by extending our sentences through using words such as 'and'.

In some of our other topic areas we are:

- Looking at the lifecycle of a butterfly.
- Learning to work as a team and playing team games during our P.E sessions.
- In R.E we will discuss people who are special to us and how we can be a good friend to others. We will discuss which stories are special to us and to Christians and Muslims. We will also read the story of 'Feeding the 5000'.
- We will recount changes in own life over time and use pictures and photographs to create a timeline and to find out information.
- We will create our own simple map of a journey.
- We will make observations of plants and animals in our school garden.
- We will learn how to use QR codes in computing.

- In phonics we will be starting Phase 4 (this includes vowels with adjacent consonants, longer words, compound words, and words ending in suffixes. Make sure to practise all our new tricky words at home too, there are lots (see above).
